Master MICKI PIPERNO

Michelangelo "Micki" Piperno, born on 25/09/72 in Rome, is a guitarist, concert player and important exponent of the acoustic fingerstyle guitar. Teacher and composer of international fame, began his studies under the guidance of Bruno Battisti D'Amario and perfected himself between the others with the famous jazz guitarist Barney Kessel. Among the artists he has collaborated with, are the names of Alex Britti (Tv Ottavo nano Tour 1999), Pino Marino (2000 Dispari Tour) with an album produced by Mauro Pagani for the Nun Entertainiment label.

Internationally renowned, he is the teacher of the first institutional course in Italy of folk acoustic guitar at the A.Casella Conservatory of L'Aquila and of fingerstyle pop guitar at the G.Braga Conservatory of Teramo. The master has participated in the most important Italian festivals such as the Acoustic Guitar Meeting in Sarzana, Ferentino Acustica, Six Bars Jail, Un Paese a Sei Corde, Salento Guitar Festival, Cremona Musica and held masterclasses in the most important institutions including: Conservatorio A .Casella of l'Aquila, Licinio Refice Conservatory of Frosinone and Cremona Musica, alongside names such as: Pierre Bensusan, Clive Carrol, Eric Lugosch, John Jorgenson.

His latest works "Guitar Story", "The drift of the continents", "Endless Horizon", "In the Air" have been presented in the most important concert institutions including the Auditorium Parco della Musica in Rome.

He has regularly collaborated in the column dedicated to the acoustic guitar on the Accordo portal and his latest solo videos are published on the channel of the American record label CandyRat Records.

Multifaceted composer, he works for Cinema, TV and Theater; he has also collaborated for didactic articles with the specialized magazines Guitarre, Ax, Accordo and published for Sinfonica Jazz, Carish Edition and Fingerpicking.net didactic manuals and compositions of original music for acoustic guitar. For two years he has been a teacher of Advanced Specialization courses at the Acoustic Guitar Village as part of the "Cremona Musica International Exhibitions and Festival". www.mickipiperno.com

Master FRANCESCO LOCCISANO

Born and raised in Calabria he began studying the guitar in 1985. His innate talent and passion for the "Chitarra Battente" (southern Italian folk guitar) led him to develop his own personal style of composition, interpretation and performance, to the point of placing artistic emphasis to the instrument that originally served as an accompaniment to singing.

Due to his passion, the chitarra battente now enjoys a broad repertoire without disregarding its origins and roots and Francesco Loccisano is considered by critics as a virtuoso of the chitarra battente on the international scene.

In 2005 he joined Eugenio Bennato's Taranta Power, with whom played an intense concert schedule at national and international level (Egypt, Wales, Canada, England, Morocco, Ethiopia, Mozambique, France, Spain, Tunisia, Kossovo and other countries).

Other collaborations include: Carlos Saura, Luigi Cinque, Antonio Infantino, Riccardo Tesi, Bob Brozman, Tony Bungaro, Mimmo Cavallaro, Miguel Angel Berna, Gianna Nannini, Vinicio Capossela, Christina Pluhar.
